EvidenceWorks® Digital Interview Recording equipment and repository to replace the legacy audio cassette technology. Since inception the programme has expanded to become the force's strategic platform for managing all digital multimedia evidence, including CCTV and Body Worn Video.

The most recent developments in release 5.2 have added the ability to store evidence from miscellaneous sources, forensic image management and improved the management of multiple video files within the same evidence item.

- allow BWV footage to be managed in a consistent, audited and secure manner alongside all other evidential media

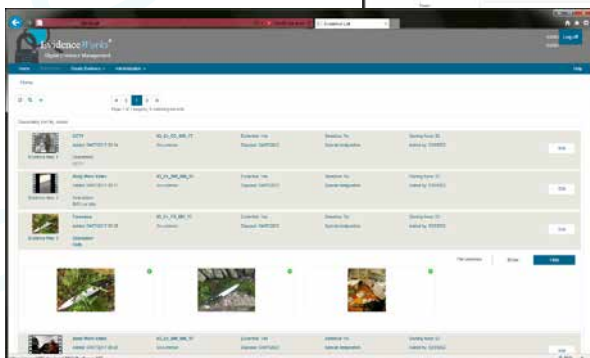
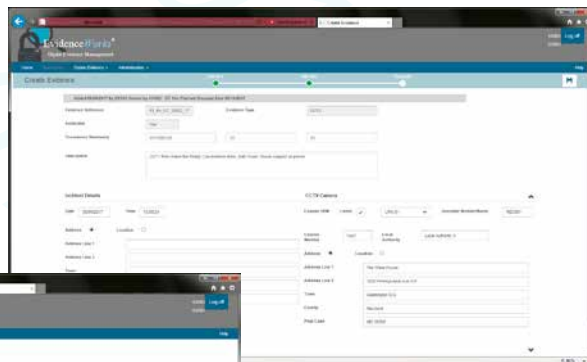


## Interface to Niche RMS

### Development Update

Key to the effectiveness of a DEM repository is its ability to interface to the force's Records Management System.
